

Circle of Fifths Chord Wheel

Make your own chord wheel to help transpose songs to a different key or even write songs.

You will need

1. Scissors
2. 1 Paper fastener pin
3. Optionally use card or laminate later.

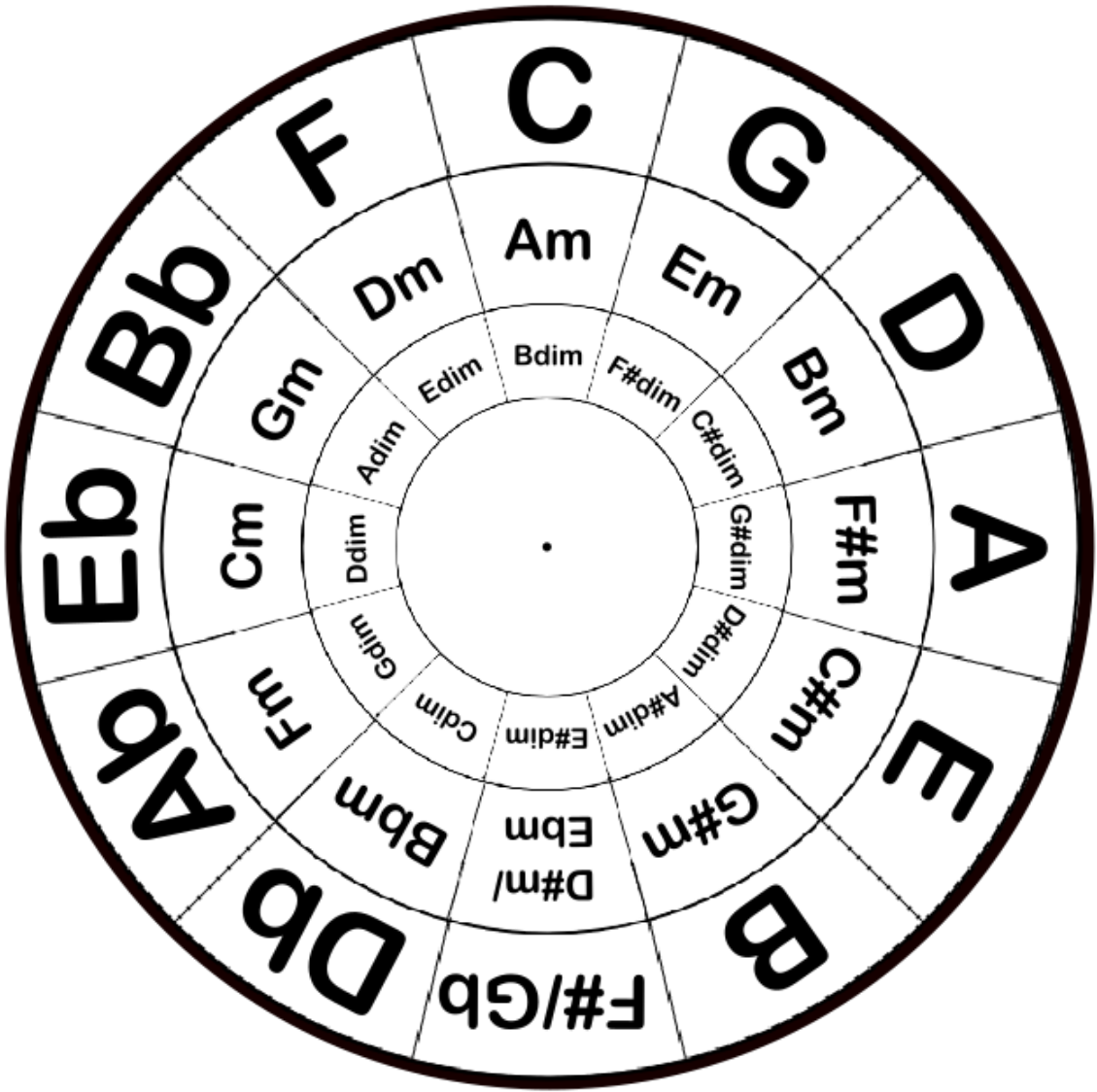
Instructions

1. Print out pages 2 (Bottom) and 3 (Top) on either card or paper.
2. Cut out both circles.
3. Using the top circle (page 2) cut out the area labelled “Cut out this white section”
4. Optional – If you have use of a laminator, you can laminate each circle.
5. Pierce a hole in the centre of each wheel.
6. Using the paper fastener pin both wheels together.

To Use

1. Turn the bottom circle until the key you wish to play in is pointing to “Main Key”.
2. The wheel will now show you which chords are in that key. You can then use this to transpose a song to a different key.
3. If you wish to follow chord progressions the chords are laid out as follows:

IV (4)	I (1)	V (5)
II (2)	VI (6)	III (3)
	VII (7)
